

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Entry forms accompanied by membership money and entry fees must be sent to Secretary by Sunday 5th July 2025. Entries lodged after this date - until 9.15am on show day - will not be included in the catalogue.
2. All entries must be competitor's own work.
3. All entries must be shown on white paper plates.
4. No competitor may enter more than once in each class.
5. All exhibits must be on the table in the Industrial Tent by 9.20 am. on show day. Entry into tent from 8a.m. Entries cannot be removed until 4p.m.
6. Entries must be collected by 5.30p.m. on the day of the show - any entries not collected by 5.30p.m. are the responsibility of the entrant and the committee accept no responsibility for any damage/loss of entries.
7. Prize money will be paid to exhibitors in the Industrial Tent from 1.30p.m. to 3.30p.m. Prize money not collected will be put back into Show Funds.
8. Every care is taken of exhibits, but the Committee accept no responsibility for any loss or damage.
9. Exhibition labels will be provided and must be securely attached to each article, along with exhibitors name (and age if under 26)
10. Any competitor disregarding these conditions will be disqualified and forfeit all entry fees and prizes.
11. The Committee reserves the right to refuse an entry.
